Students have unlimited access to sports facilities and classes, ranging from football to climbing (*€30 annual fee, plus an additional €20 for outdoor nautical activities*).

**Surfing and diving sites** only 15 minutes from the city centre.

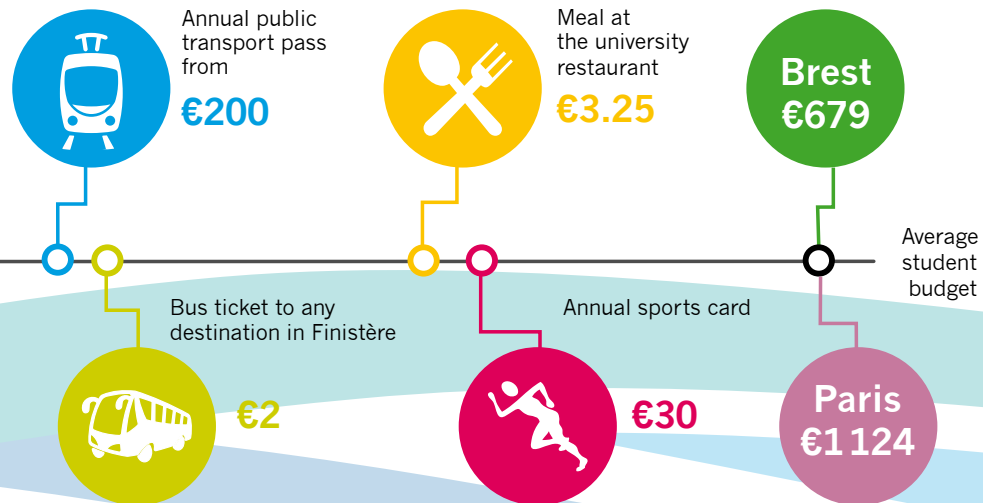
### AN OUTSTANDING ENVIRONMENT

Brest and its magnificent natural harbour offers all the advantages of a major city while retaining its local charm. An extensive transport network serves the city centre and surrounding areas, making local amenities and facilities easy to access.

### AN AFFORDABLE PLACE TO LIVE

A room with an internet connection costs around **€240 per month**.

- Affordable accommodation is offered by the university and through private landlords: Rental prices in Brest are €7.64/m<sup>2</sup> compared to €11.70/m<sup>2</sup> in Rennes or Nantes and over €25/m<sup>2</sup> in Paris.



Students may be eligible for government benefits to help pay their rent. The amount awarded depends on income, family size, study location, amount of rent and occupation status.
